Studio Policies

- * We request that students carefully observe our dress code in all classes. We strictly enforce our dress code with a no excuses or exceptions policy.
- * Students must be at least 3 years of age and potty trained to attend class.
- * **Any student arriving more than 15 minutes late will not be admitted to class.** For their safety and to receive full benefit from their class, please arrange for a make-up class if you expect to be late.
- * All students are encouraged not to leave the room once class has begun. Please allow for appropriate restroom use prior to class. Very young children will be treated sensitively as the need arises.
- * School age children and teens: *please practice respect.* Students are not to be socializing in a disruptive manner during the class with other students. Please honor your teacher and fellow students by giving your full attention and cooperation. You will be advised if we feel any student is not well adjusted to the classroom environment.
- * Dancers may not play on the railings, run or horseplay in the dancer's lounge and we expect you to clean up after yourself.
- * During class if a student complains of being ill, or sustains an injury and cannot participate, they will be taken to the front desk and a parent will be notified.
- * If your dancer is going to be absent from class please call the dance studio or email us and let us know. Make up classes can be done at the same or lower level.
- * No cell phones or food are allowed in the dance rooms.
- * We strongly suggest you bring HEALTHY food into the studio for dinner or snacks. Fast food is not an appropriate fuel for dancers when they are between classes. A refrigerator and microwave are available for use. Healthy food options are available for purchase at the front desk.

- * Absolutely no cell phone use in the locker rooms

- * The Dance Zoo will make every effort to immediately contact the parent or guardian in case of illness or injury. However in an emergency, where time is of the essence, Dance Zoo staff will assess the illness or injury and determine the next step of care which may mean arrangement for emergency transport to a medical doctor or hospital.

- * Please drop off your dancer no more than 15 minutes before their first class and pick them up in a timely manner.

- * The primary means of communication of information to parents is via email. It is the parent's responsibility to make sure that the correct email address is in their online Jackrabbit account.
